

Alaron Nuclear Services Wampum, Pennsylvania

Alaron Nuclear Services' licensed and integrated radioactive materials facility is located about 30 minutes north of Pittsburgh, Pa., where it has consistently provided nuclear services related to the nuclear power generation industry for more than three decades. Veolia purchased Alaron in the early 1990s, and it became a part of Veolia Nuclear Solutions – Federal Services (VNSFS) in 2019.

Alaron offers storage, decontamination and testing services for companies that own contaminated equipment and want the option of value engineering that Alaron provides. Alaron's core competencies include management of contaminated waste, recycling, asset recovery, facility access and support for motor and pump refurbishment, transportation, radioactive material shipping, radioactive material storage, "hot" machine shop and coating/painting services.



Alaron also provides speciality and field services, including: outage on-site project support; transloading (truck to rail), and license transfer.

Alaron adds a commercial nuclear resumé to VNSFS' capabilities, which are primarily focused on serving the U.S. Department of Energy market.
